CLASSES

Class 1: Monochrome (Black and white or one overall tone e.g. sepia.)

Class 2: Landscape

Class 3: Animals

Class 4: VAS Sunrise/Sunset within 50km of Wodonga- See Conditions 11 for more info.

Class 5: Human Study

Class 6: VAS JUNIOR Photo of Spiders Web - See Conditions 11 for more info.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All entries must clearly state the entrants name, address, phone number and class on the back.
3. Collect entries from the steward at the display area in the Ladies Pavilion from between 3pm and 4pm on the day of the show or organise other arrangements in advance (before the day of the show) with the steward for the collection of your entries.
4. All work must be the work of the exhibitor who must be an amateur (Someone that does not derive the greater percentage of their income as a photographer). Computer generated images are not acceptable - all entries must contain actual photographs taken by the entrant in the last 12 months. Commercial processing is acceptable.
5. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
6. All possible care will be taken of entries but no responsibility is accepted by the Wodonga Show Society Inc. for any loss or damage during the exhibition, storage or transit.
9. If any class attracts less than five (5) entries, then those entries may be put in another appropriate class by the Steward.
10. The work is hung at the Chief Steward's discretion.
11. (a) Entries in ALL Sections must be mounted on **CARDBOARD** only.
(b) **All prints must be clearly labelled on the back with the entrant's name, address, phone number and class.**
(c) Prints for classes 1, 2, 3 and 5 can be any size with any size border. Prints in classes 4 and 6 must be no larger than 20cm by 30cm with the mount creating a border no larger than 3cm.
(d) For class 3, location where photo was taken must also be labelled on the back of the photo. This must be within 50km of Wodonga to be eligible. Winner of this section is eligible for the Group Final.
(e) For Class 6 the exhibitor must be aged under 18 on the day of the show (17th March 2018) so must record their age on the back of the entry. The location where photo was taken must also be labelled on the back of the photo and must be within 50km of Wodonga to be eligible. The winner of class 6 is eligible for the Junior Group Final.

Photographs should have good technical quality, good composition and impact/appeal or tell a story.
