Wodonga Show Society grant application success!

The Wodonga Show Society will receive a grant of \$9,977 to upgrade an amenities block at the Wodonga Showgrounds.

The successful Agricultural and Pastoral Society Grants Program 2024-25 application will be used to replace a hot water service; shower taps; basin taps; toilets and toilet roll holders.

The honourable Ros Spence MP, Minister for Agriculture, formally advised the Society of the successful grant application outcome last month.

The amenities block is used by visitors staying in the Society's caravan park and by the Albury Wodonga Woodcrafters and the Murray Railway Modellers.

In 2024–25, the Victorian Government has made available funding of up to \$300,000 under the Program. The program is available to support agricultural and pastoral societies to stimulate community involvement across Victoria in activities that promote agriculture.

"The Wodonga Show Society is extremely to the Minister for Agriculture for the grant to upgrade our amenities block," said Diana Johnston, Wodonga Show Society Secretary.

"We were overwhelmed by the community support at the Bunnings BBQ on Sunday 10 November that raised funds to ensure the 2025 Wodonga Show remains an affordable country show for everyone.
